**IMPORTANT INFORMATION:** On joining, or renewing with the LDAS, you receive a welcome letter outlining the club benefits and a brief list of some of the more important **Club Rules**. As in many cases it is always the few who manage to disrespect the Rules, and make what should be an enjoyable experience, a frustrating one. We do not have 'specimen' carp in our waters so there is no need to fish using large hooks. Here is a brief reminder of these essential Rules;

Recent bailiff patrols at Long Copse have revealed that some reminder of the fishery rules is called for, so members are respectfully reminded of the following requirements when fishing at Long Copse:-

- Bread or any floating bait may not be used
- · Ground bait can not be used just a modest quantity of free offerings
- · Barbed hooks are not to be used nor any hook larger than size 8
- · Only one rod (which must not be left unattended) to be used at any one time
- · You must have a suitable landing net and unhooking mat in your swim
- · Keepnets may only be used in published matches

If a member would like to talk to a bailiff or a coach about the correct tackle, please ask.
